- 992 capacity was acceptable more than 5 FFE in Resource, Spec. Ed
- Combine B01/B24
- Autism – Need sensory gym adjacent. 3 programs need sensory gym
- Special Ed office adjacent to resource room
- Title curriculum – (3-4 children per adult) – current title room about size of board room @ mt. stuart – literacy blocks in morning.

Site Discussion:

Mt. Stuart

- No queuing for buses at fire access lane, can be an issue at current site
- Bus loop (diagram on left is preferred) Prefer image on right because busses completely separate.
- Prefer access further up Cora street away from intersection

New ES

- City park discussion
 - 12 acres west of Cora vs 18 needed
 - Trees are 1.5 acres (1.5 acre well to take out too)
 - Need to make additional room on east side of Cora (don't know if city will require Illinois be extended)

Strong desire to connect trail, trail head, park area, public use

Buses:

- After school 7 buses at Mt Stuart (+1 small special ed)
 - Could be reduced 5 Mt Stuart, 4 Lincoln, 4 new school
- Transporting 1565 students (median)
 - Half of student population
 - Afternoons (60+) kids every bus

Schedule:

Mt Stuart

- Morning – students go to playground or breakfast
- Afternoon –students line up at playground or bus or flag pole (parking lot)

18 students – walk home – cross 15th

Discussion:

Entrance should not be from west
Both schools have warming kitchens only
