Executive Committee Meeting – Ellensburg School District #401 Board Room.

- I. Buses
 - A. Spec. Ed. Bus Drop.
 - 1. Spec. Ed. Bus drop –
 - a. Consider keeping at west side for both preschool & connections.
 - b. Separate Spec. Ed. & preschool drop location
 - c. Preschool has 3 dedicated shorter buses.
 - d. Operate 3x day 30 ft buses.
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- II. General Discussion
 - A. Comments:
 - 1. Specialist at Core - Good for Patty – Resource at center, near title.

2. Consider orienting the building 45 degrees SE.
 - a. Mark D – Be cautious of fractured pieces.
3. Coordinate and track fire lanes which go around the building.
4. Jinger – There are pros and Cons of both Mt Stuart options.
5. Jonathon – Consider keeping the front door at Cora.
6. Jinger – Preference for the first initial site scheme layout.
7. Dan – Like the school closer to the nature space but saving more area for the middle school is important.
8. Jonathon – Let's see what the 2nd Option looks like on the SE corner.
9. Eric – Consider that there will be bus traffic both north and south on Cora from the New ES Site.
10. Jinger- Prefers the longer python/ missing tooth arrangement or the flexibility vs the pea pod/grape cluster for grade level alignment.
11. Rusty Question – Supervision question regarding breakout space - keeping eyes on. Will be considered during design of glazing from classrooms to corridor and shared learning.

III. New ES – North Site

- A. Comments on layout:
 1. Dale- Keep playgrounds to the south.
 2. Building can go toward the south, playfields can move into that area.
 3. Parent ingress/egress can be on Helena for separation of bus traffic
 4. ESD would like to see a wholistic look at the site with the option for a future Middle school and traffic.
